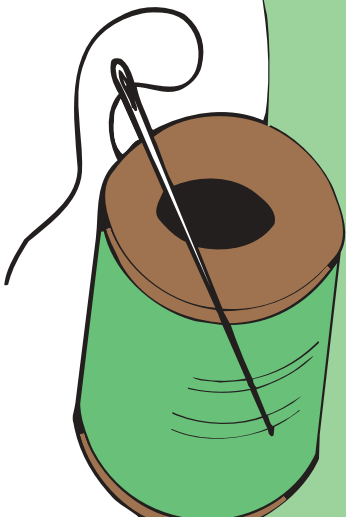

## Dorcas Served Jesus

The people of Joppa loved Dorcas because she helped them and showed God's love. Cut out this picture of Dorcas on the outer black line and glue it to the center of the paper plate your leader will provide (to cover the hole). Cut out the memory verse strip in the version your leader indicates. (The red words are the KJV verse, and the blue words are NIV.) Starting at the top of the plate, use yarn to sew around the edge of the plate, then tie the ends together at the top for a hanger. Dab a thin layer of oil on the back of the picture. Hang your suncatcher in a window at home. It will remind you that Dorcas is a good example of loving and serving Jesus by doing God's work and helping others.
