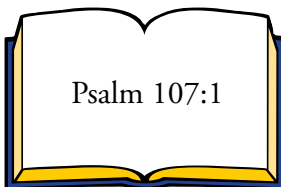
Jacob was more comfortable indoors.

He liked to be around his mother while she cooked. Jacob was smaller and had smooth, fair skin. (Genesis 27:1-38, 42-43)

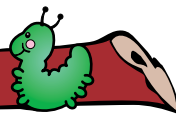
**Help Esau find his way to his father. Trace the way he should go.**
